

Third Cross-border Workshop of the Capacity Building Project

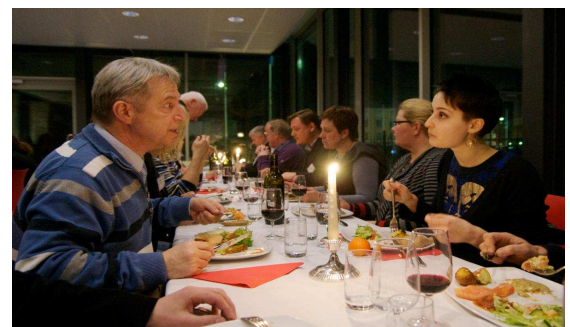
